Three Common Q&A

1. If you see multiple time punches below a shift, it indicates that employees are clocking IN and OUT instead of using GO ON BREAK

- Please ask employees to use the break feature to make things cleaner going forward
- To fix existing split time punches, please use the MERGE button shown below. Then, when you APPROVE the punches, the results will be cleaner and make more sense.
